

Daily Bible Study Guide for April 12–18

We are going in a new direction with our Study Guides. In order to encourage as many people as possible to read through their Bibles with us this year, we are doing away with the sermon study guides and focusing instead on our daily Bible reading plan.

The reading plan is indicated for each day in this Study Guide. After reading the assigned chapters, follow this four-step process:

Scripture: Write out, word-for-word, a verse that caught your attention while reading.

Observation: Write down some interesting things you see in the verse you chose. What does the verse teach you about God? Is there a promise to claim? Is there a command to obey? Are there questions you have about the content of the verse?

Application: What does this verse say I am supposed to do? How can my life change for the better because of what this verse is saying to me? What will I do today because of what I read to day?

Prayer: What kind of help do I need (from God and/or others) so I can apply the principle(s) found in my verse for the day? What needs do my family and friends have that I can give to God on their behalf? How has God been answering my previous prayers?

Read: Mark 11; Joshua 17, 18

Scripture: Write out, word-for-word, a verse that caught your attention while reading.

Observation: Write down some interesting things you see in the verse you chose.

Application: What does this verse say I am supposed to do?

Prayer: What kind of help do I need so I can apply the principle(s) found in my verse?

Tuesday, April 13

Read: Mark 12; Joshua 19, 20

Scripture: Write out, word-for-word, a verse that caught your attention while reading.

Observation: Write down some interesting things you see in the verse you chose.

Application: What does this verse say I am supposed to do?

Prayer: What kind of help do I need so I can apply the principle(s) found in my verse?

Wednesday, April 14

Read: Mark 13; Joshua 21, 22

Scripture: Write out, word-for-word, a verse that caught your attention while reading.

Observation: Write down some interesting things you see in the verse you chose.

Application: What does this verse say I am supposed to do?

Prayer: What kind of help do I need so I can apply the principle(s) found in my verse?

Thursday, April 15

Read: Mark 14; Joshua 23, 24

Scripture: Write out, word-for-word, a verse that caught your attention while reading.

Observation: Write down some interesting things you see in the verse you chose.

Application: What does this verse say I am supposed to do?

Prayer: What kind of help do I need so I can apply the principle(s) found in my verse?

Friday, April 16

Read: Mark 15; Judges 1, 2

Scripture: Write out, word-for-word, a verse that caught your attention while reading.

Application: What does this verse say I am supposed to do?

Prayer: What kind of help do I need so I can apply the principle(s) found in my verse?

Saturday, April 17

Read: Mark 16; Judges 3, 4

Scripture: Write out, word-for-word, a verse that caught your attention while reading.

Prayer: What kind of help do I need so I can apply the principle(s) found in my verse?

Sunday, April 18

Read: 1 Corinthians 1; Judges 5, 6
