

Daily Bible Reading Journal for May 17–May 23

The Bible Reading Journal is provided for you so you can get the most out of your daily Bible reading.

The reading plan is indicated for each day in this Study Guide. After reading the assigned chapters, follow this four-step process:

Scripture: Write out, word for word, a verse that caught your attention while reading.

Observation: Write down some interesting things you see in the verse you chose. What does the verse teach you about God? Is there a promise to claim? Is there a command to obey? Are there questions you have about the content of the verse?

Application: What does this verse say or imply I am supposed to do? How can my life change for the better because of what this verse is saying to me? What will I do today because of what I read today?

Prayer: What kind of help do I need (from God and/or others) so I can apply the principle(s) found in my verse for the day? What needs do my family and friends have that I can give to God on their behalf? How has God been answering my previous prayers?

Monday, May 17

Read: Psalm 42,43,44; 2 Sam 9,10

Scripture: Write out, word for word, a verse that caught your attention while reading.

Observation: Write down some interesting things you see in the verse you chose.

Application: What does this verse say or imply I am supposed to do?

Prayer: What kind of help do I need so I can apply the principle(s) found in my verse?

Tuesday, May 18

Read: Psalm 45,46; 2 Samuel 11,12

Scripture: Write out, word for word, a verse that caught your attention while reading.

Observation: Write down some interesting things you see in the verse you chose.

Application: What does this verse say or imply I am supposed to do?

Prayer: What kind of help do I need so I can apply the principle(s) found in my verse?

Wednesday, May 19

Read: Psalm 47,48,49; 2 Samuel 13,14

Scripture: Write out, word for word, a verse that caught your attention while reading.

Observation: Write down some interesting things you see in the verse you chose.

Application: What does this verse say or imply I am supposed to do?

Prayer: What kind of help do I need so I can apply the principle(s) found in my verse?

Thursday, May 20

Read: Psalm 50,51; 2 Samuel 15,16

Scripture: Write out, word for word, a verse that caught your attention while reading.

Friday, May 21

Read: Psalm 52,53; 2 Samuel 17,18

Read: Psalm 54,55; 2 Samuel 19,20
